

STAY WITH YOUR FIRE PIT WHENEVER IT'S LIT

i Fire pits and outdoor fireplaces can be dangerous if not used correctly.



There are simple actions you can take to reduce the risk of fire when using a firepit.

KEEP CLEAR

The fire pit should be kept **CLEAR** of structures or foliage. Do not place the fire pit on a flammable surface.

PUT OUT

Always have continuous supply of water or a fire extinguisher ready to completely **PUT OUT** the fire when you are finished.

WATCH

Always have a responsible adult **WATCH** and control the fire. Only burn clean, dry, well-seasoned wood. Keep a **WATCH** on the weather, do not use a fire pit if it is too windy or there is a total fire ban.

Always **WATCH** children and pets around a fire pit.

Remove debris from last fire before starting a new fire.
